TRAINEE REQUIREMENTS : - Namibian citizen

- No older than 24 years at date of registration

- Proficiency in English is essential (speak, read, write)

- Minimum Grade 10 pass (evidence required), or

relevant industry experience

- Outgoing personality with good communication,
